On April 14th, although they had received warnings, the crew of the Titanic saw an iceberg in front of them. It was too late to do anything - the ship hit the iceberg. There were 20 lifeboats on the Titanic, with a capacity for 1,178 people not enough for the 2,208 people on

the ship. What is more, lots of people did not want to leave the ship - until it was too late. The lifeboats went away with about 650 people in them, while 1,559 passengers and crew remained on board. Only fifty-five people survived the icy

In Titanic he plays third-class passenger Jack Dawson.




